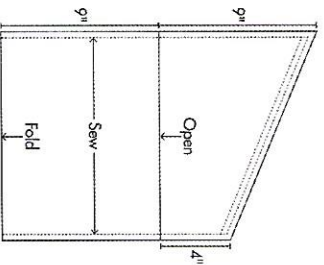
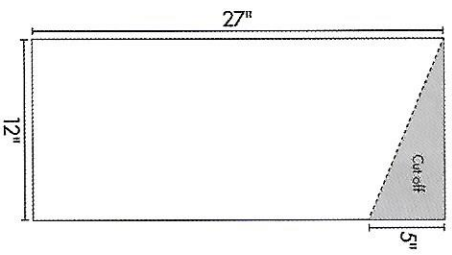

SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- 18" x36" Kunin® Eco-fi Plus™ Premiumfelt™; Red
- 9" x12" Kunin® Eco-fi™ Classicfelt™; Black
- Black thread
- 1/4" round Velcro® hook-&-loop fasteners
- Sizzix®:
 - Bigz BIGkick/Big Shot die: Circles
 - Big Shot™ die-cut machine
- Fabri-Tac™ permanent adhesive
- Marking pencil
- Scissors
- Rotary cutter, cutting mat, acrylic ruler
- Sewing machine
- Basic sewing supplies
- Optional: 2 1/2", 2 1/4" & 2" circle templates

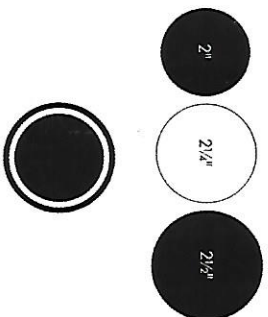
DIRECTIONS:

1. Cut a 12"x27" rectangle from red felt. Place ruler at one corner of 12" end. Measure up 5" on opposite side. Angle ruler at 5" mark. Cut off piece.

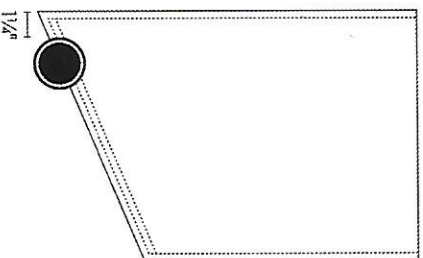


2. Fold opposite end of felt over 9", match side seams. Top stitch on both sides to create a pocket. Top stitch front flap.

3. Use Bigz die to cut circles from black felt and red felt, or cut three circles, using 2 1/2", 2 1/4" and 2" templates. Stack circles and glue together.



4. Glue circle stack to corner of case, 1 1/4" from the edge.



5. Place three round hook-&-loop fasteners along the edge of the flap to close.
