

# NEW MEXICO BEAUTY

A Jelly Roll Friendly 9°Wedge Ruler Pattern

This quilt pattern was inspired by the many variation of the popular New York Beauty quilts. Students will learn how to piece strip sets, cut wonderful pieced wedges, assemble the wedges into fans and half circles, then general block assembly.

BACKGROUND                      4 1/4 yards  
1 JELLY ROLL

Other Supplies Needed: rotary cutter, mat and ruler, sewing machine, neutral thread for sewing, thread to match background fabric, 9° Wedge Ruler, basic sewing and quilting supplies.

I suggest that students do some pre-class cutting, so we can make the most of sewing time during class. Please cut the following before you come to class.

**Please bring all remaining fabric with you to class.**

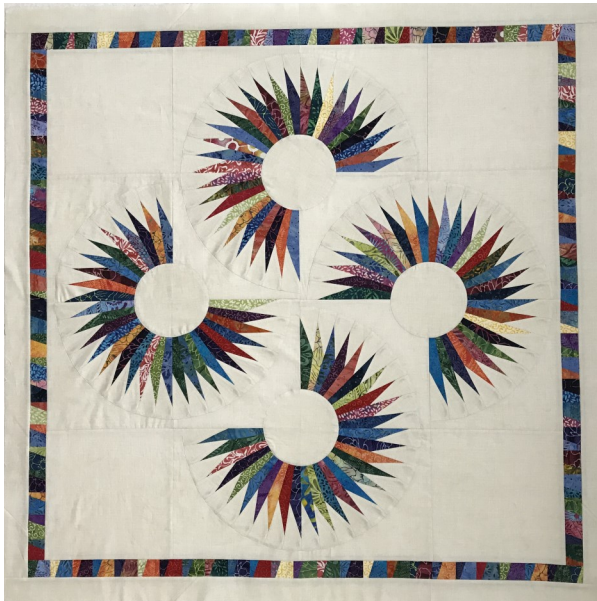
All strips are cut across the width of the fabric.

BACKGROUND

Cut 24 strips, each 2 1/2" wide, cut into:  
120 - 2 1/2" x 8"

JELLY ROLL

Cut 120 - 2 1/2" x 8" (I cut 3 from each of my jelly roll strips)



9° Circle Wedge rulers will be available to purchase for \$28.
