

Hand Piecing Resources

Why hand piecing?

Very portable, you can take it practically anywhere

Much easier to sew Y seams (inset) and curves

No brainer...sew following the printed line

Relaxing (especially once you get the hang of it)

Small hands? Not a problem...fabric squishes up while sewing unlike paper templates

All you need is fabric, thread, needle, threader, scissors and a few pins.
