Class Supplies Needed:

Color Journal (see Notes below)
Paper and writing utensil (for notes)
Scraps (LOTS AND LOTS of YOUR fabric scraps – the more the better)
Color Wheel (e.g. The Color Wheel Co. color wheel)
Glue stick (e.g. Elmer's Disappearing Purple)

Optional / Extra Supplies:

Optional kit (See Notes below)
One (1) show and tell item – something you might think is “off” but you don't know why – we can discuss as a class – NO JUDGMENT – safe space to get some ideas

Notes:

- **Color Journal:** Notebook or Journal to a size *not less than* 6-1/2" x 9" to accommodate swatches. (You want something portable and easy to write / sketch / glue things into.) You will be starting your color journal so something that accommodates recording your notes, thoughts, inspirations, references, etc. is what you need as your Color Journal.
- **Optional Kit:** Presenter will have an optional kit available (\$20) which includes materials to complete exercises in a medium other than fabric for an in-depth / more immersive experience of color.
- **Books:** Books on color are numerous across all mediums!!! A recommended resource list will be circulated in class.

IMPORTANT: Come to class with an attitude that will allow you to laugh a lot, learn even more, and PLAY (lots of play – how we experiment and try things out without consequences). There are no tests and no wrong answers so come prepared to enjoy yourself and increase your knowledge of color. (Fun IS allowed, you know.)
